





 - Step (i) Click the text tool in tool group.
 Step (ii) Click the position where you want to place the text. A text box with a cursor appear.
 Step (iii) Select the desired colour for the text from the colour 1 option and start typing.
 - 4. Magnifier tool is used to enlarge the size of a drawing. Right click on the part of the drawing you can reduce the magnification level.
 - 5. Text tool, Polygon tool, Color Picker tool, Magnifier tool.






